General provisions

The Pannonian association is the organizer of the 21st edition of the festival in extreme sports, Pannonian Challenge (Festival), which will take place at Osijek, Croatia.

- 07. 06. 2020. – BMX Finals

Rules for participation

- 1)** By participating in this events, you agree to be bound by all Pannonian Challenge and UCI Regulations and Policies.
- 2)** By participating you agree to be bound by all standard Pannonian Challenge Rules and Conditions.
- 3)** Each participant is engaged on their own behalf and those of their employees and agents, and must observe all the provisions of the Technical Guide.
- 4)** Every participant shall follow the directions of the organization and appointed officials, and any penalties that may be applied.
- 5)** Ignorance of the provisions of the Technical Guide or the events schedule shall not be admitted as an excuse by any rider in any circumstances.
- 6)** You certify that you have no contraindications (medical or otherwise) to practice a sport in competition.
- 7)** You authorize the intervention of first aid, and if necessary, your transfer to medical services at the sole discretion of the event staff and event first aid personnel.
- 8)** You authorize Pannonian Challenge and any other event Partners to:
 - film and / or photograph you.
 - reproduce, exploit and disseminate whatever the medium, or the content produced.
 - use your image and the said product contents whether for commercial and / or promotional purposes.
- 9)** You will not disrupt the run / practice of another rider.
- 10)** You are responsible for the supply of your own safety equipment.
- 11)** You will not endanger any audience member or other participants during your run / practice.

12) You will not swear, act aggressively, or act in any way that may damage the reputation of Pannonian Challenge and any other Partners. This will be enforced at the sole discretion of the event organizer.

13) You agree that you have entered these events on your own free will and you grant this from this day you will not ask for any remuneration or financial contribution from Pannonian Challenge or any other event partners.

Penalties for violation of these requirements could include disqualification from the events, stripping of prizes / prize money that you may have been awarded and bans from future events.

Competition rules

Regulations of skateboarding, inline and BMX competition at Pannonian Challenge and Challenge Tour 2020.

Every entered person can take part in the competition, which:

- finds in writing that their health allows their to take part in competitions,
- minors will submit their parents permission to start their competition and their statement that their health allows them to take part in competitions,
- has a technically efficient bicycle, rollerblades and skateboard
- paid the starting fee
- will use a protective helmet during training and competition (except skateboarding)
- competitors who want to take part in the BMX Freestyle C1 UCI event must have valid cycling licenses

Responsibility

- 1)** The organizer is not liable for damage caused by the sole fault of the aggrieved party or a third party for which he is not responsible.
- 2)** For accidents that may happen during competition on skatepark obstacles located on the festival grounds, not due to negligence of the staff or the Organizer, the person using the obstacles for sport risk principle is solely responsible.
- 3)** In the event of an injury or accident on the festival grounds, each victim is obliged to notify the staff of this fact immediately.
- 4)** For damages caused to other participants in situations where their occurrence could not be prevented despite the personnel's due diligence, the perpetrator is responsible for the damage or the legal guardian's parents or legal guardians are liable.
- 5)** The staff are not responsible for things left unattended on the festival grounds.

Final Provisions

- 1)** By joining the Festival, the participant agrees to the terms of these regulations: for the processing of his personal data for the purpose of carrying out and implementation of the festival, and for publicly sharing his personal data and image in connection with the competition, in particular in the media by accepting the content of the statement required when making a notification.

2) Pannonian reserves the right to change the regulations at any time. In this case, the information about the changes will be published in the same way as the original rules were announced.

3) In matters not regulated in these regulations, the relevant provisions of law shall apply, in particular the Civil Code and the Act on Copyright and Related Rights.

4) Regulations come into force on February 24, 2020.

GDPR - General Data Protection Regulation

In connection with the start of application on February 24, 2020 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and the repeal of the Directive 95/46/EC (general regulation on data protection) (hereinafter "the Regulation") we inform you that from February 24, 2020 you will be entitled to the rights set out below in relation to the processing of The Pannonian association; ul. Cara Hadrijana 5, 31000 Osijek, Croatia, your personal data.

At the same time, pursuant to art. 13 of the Regulation, we inform that:

The Pannonian association your personal data for the following purposes:

- a) the inclusion of data in the participants' internal system;
- b) preparing and issuing run bands;
- c) preparing and printing start lists and placing lists on the website of the organized professions;
- d) preparing, printing lists with the results of individual competitions and displaying a letter in the Competition Office and skatepark;
- e) placing lists with the results of individual categories on the website of the organized professions, on the social networking site Facebook, and the Instagram application
- f) place data on the lists of people for medal decorations;
- g) posting data and providing letters to media partners and sponsors

The basis for the processing of your data is the legitimate interest pursued by Pannonian through which the organization of the event resulting from the implementation of the

Pannonian statutory objectives should be understood.

In connection with the processing of data for the purposes indicated in point 3 above, your personal data may be shared with other recipients or categories of recipients of personal data.

The recipients of your data may be:

- a) Pannonian employees and collaborators
- b) external entities and their employees or co-workers, preparing and printing start lists;
- c) external entities and their employees or co-workers, preparing and printing letters with the results of individual categories;
- d) Pannonian volunteers;
- e) companies and drivers of vehicles cooperating with Pannonian in the organization;
- f) hotels, centers, pensions with which Pannonian cooperates in order to organize;
- g) other participants of the organized professions;
- h) persons within the organized professions; i) users of the website, social networking site Facebook, Instagram application

Your personal data will be processed for the period necessary for implementation indicated in point.

Your data will not be processed in an automated way as well as in the form of profiling.

In relation to the processing of your personal data by Pannonian, you are entitled to:

- a. the right to access the data content;
- b. the right to rectify the data;
- c. the right to delete data;
- d. the right to limit data processing;
- e. the right to object to the processing;

Providing your personal data by you is voluntary, but necessary to participate in organized competitions.

Pannonian will not transfer your personal data to a third country (outside the European Union or the European Economic Area) or to international organizations.
